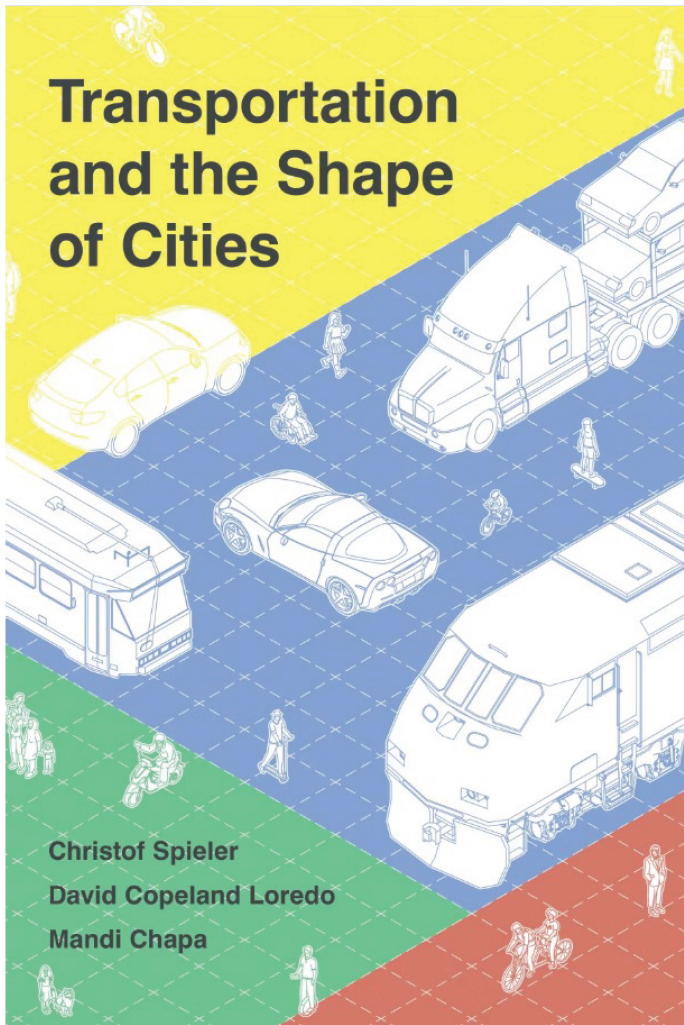

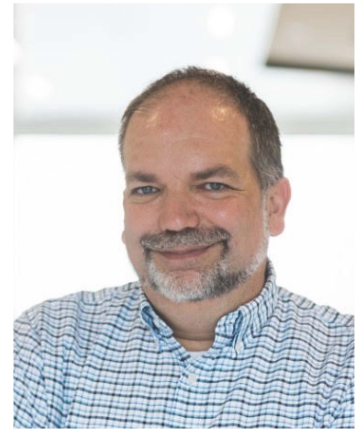

Christof Spieler will be the featured speaker at an upcoming District 11 Book Club event highlighting his new book, **Transportation and the Shape of Cities** (2026).



Drawing from the book, Spieler will discuss how transportation shapes cities, with a focus on Madison's evolving transportation network. **Transportation and the Shape of Cities** examines the five major modes of U.S. transportation, from walking and bicycling to automobiles, trains, and transit, and explores how they influence urban design and community development.
